- ___ 1. Completed Demolition Permit Application from the Building Department.
- ___ 2. Copy of the recorded deed showing current owner.
- ___ 3. A plot plan approved by the Park County Planning and Zoning Dept. indicating the location of existing and proposed structure(s) to be demolished from the property lines and from each other, a north arrow, roads or streets, septic tanks, leaching areas, driveway, stream beds or drainage ways, easements, property lines and dimensions.
- ___ 4. Submit in writing the method of disposal for the materials resulting from the demolition. Materials must be removed from the property within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of demolition.
- ___ 5. A map, including directions on how to get to the property from a major highway or road. The map should include a north arrow, all street or road names and any landmarks that may be helpful in locating the property.
- ___ 6. \$100.00 Fee

I hereby certify that I have read and examined this application and know the same to be true and correct. All provisions of laws and ordinances governing this type of work will be complied with whether specified herein or not. The granting of a permit does not presume to give the authority to violate or cancel the provisions of any other state or local law regulating construction, the performance of construction, zoning or sanitation requirements.

This permit becomes null and void if work or construction authorized is not commenced within 180 days, or if construction or work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days at any time after work is commenced.
