Friday, 02/23/2018 Attempt to Locate for a Warrant Results in a Four-mile Foot Pursuit

On Friday, February 23 at approximately 12:00 PM deputies observed a party known to have an active felony warrant out of the State of Kansas behind a residence on Arapahoe trail near Hartsel. The deputies approached the front door of the residence and after knocking and announcing, were able to see the party run out of the back door.

Both deputies began a foot pursuit with one deputy coming under attack from the resident's dog. When the pursuit continued despite the deputies' orders to stop and furtive movements by the party causing the deputies to suspect a weapon a TASER was deployed but due to the winter coveralls worn by the fugitive this was ineffective.

After a mile into the chase one deputy returned to the residence for his vehicle while the other continued for another estimated three miles. At one point this deputy was able to jump on the running board of a passing truck and catch up to the runner. When he dismounted and got a hand on the party, his momentum caused him to fall and the chase continued.

Meanwhile the second deputy arrived with his vehicle and the chase continued over rough terrain. The deputy saw the party turn back toward the first deputy and still with the strong suspicion that the party had a weapon, used his opened car door to knock the runner down and then he deployed his TASER.

The party continued to resist being handcuffed even after both deputies worked to apply restraints.

The party was cleared by EMTs and transported to the Park County Jail. In addition to the extraditable Kansas warrant, he was charged with Obstructing a Peace Officer and Resisting Arrest.

Tuesday, 02/27/2018 Attempt to Locate for a Warrant Leads to Two Arrests

While attempting to locate (ATL) a female party in Harris Park with an outstanding warrant deputies observed the wanted person in a vehicle driven by a male party who's driving privileges were revoked for a previous alcohol conviction with five additional active restraints against his license. Both parties were arrested and transported to the Park County Jail.

Thursday, 03/01/2018 Traffic Stop for Speeding-Arrest for Habitual Traffic Offender

A deputy observed a Chevrolet pickup truck northbound at mile marker 193 at an estimated 85 miles per hour in a posted 65 mph zone. Radar confirmed a speed of 84 mph. The deputy attempted to catch up to the truck and made a traffic stop at County Road 56 (mm 200). The driver was found to have his driving privileges revoked as a Habitual Traffic Offender with 38 additional active restraints against his driver's license. The male driver was arrested and transported to the Park County Jail.

Thursday, 03/01/2018 Domestic Disturbance ends in Arrest for Domestic Violence

Deputies responded to a report of a disturbance at a residence in Bailey on the evening of March 01. The male party had broken a TV and taken the telephone from the female party as she was attempting to call 911. The male was arrested and transported to the Park County Jail. He was charged with Harassment; Obstruction of Telephone or Telegraph Services; Child Abuse; Criminal Mischief and the Domestic Violence Sentence Enhancer
