**WEEKLY ACTIVITY REPORT**  
**MARCH 02, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 08, 2018**

**Friday, 03/02/2018-Recreational Shooting Caused Grassfire, Circle R subdivision**

A deputy responded to an acre and a half grass fire that was determined to have been caused by recreational shooting. No crime was committed and the fire was extinguished.

**Friday, 03/02/2018-MM 60 Hwy 9, DUI and Felony Warrant**

After observing a southbound vehicle travelling at 83 mph in a posted 65 mph zone at mm 60 on Hwy 9 a deputy initiated a traffic stop at mm 58. The driver gave indications of alcohol consumption and refused Standard Field Sobriety Tests, but elected a breath test. The Driver also had a confirmed felony warrant out of El Paso County for Larceny. The party was arrested and transported to the Park County Jail where he was booked in for the warrant and DUI.

**Friday, 03/02/2018-MM 65.5 Hwy 9, DUI**

The same deputy was once again on Hwy 9 when she observed a southbound vehicle at 72 mph in a posted 50 mph zone. During the traffic stop the deputy detected the presence of an unknown alcoholic beverage and requested the driver to perform voluntary SFSTs. The driver failed to perform these as a sober party would and was taken into custody and transported to the Park County Jail.

**Monday, 03/05/2018-warrant Arrest for Sex Assault**

A male party was taken into custody in the Pine junction area on a warrant for Sex Assault.

**Monday, 03/05/2018-Warrant at Court**

At 3:15 PM deputies responded to the park County Combined Court for a party who had a warrant for Failure to Comply. He was taken into custody and transported to the Park County Jail.

**Tuesday, 03/06/2018-Road Rage Incident Ends Peacefully**

On Tuesday, March 06 deputies received a report of a road rage incident in progress in the Hartsel area. Two parties had exchanged hand gestures at the Hartsel Post Office and the second driver followed the first driver around the area roads and made an attempt to block them off in one spot. The first driver drove to his residence and retrieved a shotgun due to his concern for his and his mother's safety. After an exchange of comments the second driver left the scene. A deputy made contact with the first party at the residence and another responding deputy made contact with the second driver on CR 15 and statements from both parties were obtained. Since neither party wanted to press charges the issue was resolved without further action.

**Tuesday, 03/06/2018-Traffic Stop for Lights and Equipment, Driver S Issued DWAI-D Summons**

A deputy made a traffic stop at Rosalie Rd. and Hwy 285 at approximately 6:00 PM on Tuesday, March 06 for a vehicle without taillights. The driver gave indications of impaired driving and attempted to perform voluntary Standard Field Sobriety Tests at the deputy's request. When he failed to complete the tests as a sober party would he was taken into custody and was transported to the Bailey Substation for a blood draw. An open container of marijuana and paraphernalia were located in the vehicle. The driver was issued a summons and released to the sober passenger who took over driving and they continued on their way to Monte Vista.

**Thursday, 03/08/2018-Booked in for Contempt of Court**

Detention Deputies responded to the Park County Combined Court to take a female party into custody and transport her to the jail to serve one hour for Contempt of Court due to her actions in the courtroom.
