WEEKLY ACTIVITY REPORT
MARCH 16, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 22, 2018

Friday, 03/16/2018-Missing Elderly Person Located and Returned to Family Member Early Friday morning (March 16, 2018 at 04:00 AM) a Deputy noticed a vehicle near Bailey on US Hwy 285 weaving erratically and braking excessively. When stopped and the disoriented elderly driver was identified he came back as a reported Missing Person out of Thornton. The Deputy provided a courtesy ride to the driver and returned him to a family member in the metro area on I-70.

Friday, 03/16/2018-Speeding by Driver with a Revoked License

At approximately 12:24 AM on Friday, March 16 a Deputy spotted a white sedan travelling northbound on US Hwy 285 in Fairplay at an estimated 90 mph in a posted 45 mph zone near the Sinclair Station. Radar confirmed a speed of 92 mph in the posted 55 mph zone and a traffic stop was conducted at mile marker 185. When contacted the driver stated that he was going to be going to jail. The driver was correct regarding this due to his license being revoked with nine additional active restraints. He was transported to the Park County Jail and charged with Drove Motor Vehicle When License is Under Restraint: Revoked; Reckless Driving and Speeding.

Friday, 03/16/2018-Domestic Violence Arrest in Grant

Deputies responded to a 911 call from a business in Grant concerning a possible domestic dispute in progress at around 3:15 PM. A female party reported that the male party had shoved her and the infant child she was holding received and injury during the confrontation. The male party was arrested and charged with Assault in the Third Degree; Domestic Violence; Child Abuse and Harassment. He was transported to the Park County Jail and booked in.

Sunday, 03/18/2018-Domestic Violence Call near Lake George

Deputies responded to a call at 1:22 PM from a female party who reported that she was walking west along Hwy 24 near Lake George, but she had been assaulted and imprisoned by her boyfriend previously. The female was located and both the male and the female were interviewed. Both parties displayed injuries, but evidence supported the female's version. Deputies located the doors which the female said had been both screwed and nailed shut to imprison her for the past five days. Other details provided by the female victim resulted in the arrest of the male party who was transported to the jail and charged with Kidnapping; Assault in the Second Degree; Menacing; False Imprisonment and Obstruction of a Telephonic Device.

Monday, 03/19/2018 Mother with Children Arrested for DUI in Fairplay

A party called into Park County Communication on Monday, March 19th in the early evening to report a visibly intoxicated female had just picked up her children from a day care home near Fairplay. Deputies received a vehicle description and located the vehicle near a local liquor store. When the female party exited the store and returned to her vehicle she was contacted by a Deputy and indications of impairment were observed. When asked to perform SFSTs the party

complied but was unable to perform them in a manner that a sober party would. The female also stated she didn't drink and was wearing an ankle monitor that would prove she didn't drink...She was arrested and charged with Child Abuse (by knowingly operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol with both of her minor children present) and Drove a Motor Vehicle while Under the Influence of Alcohol. The children were released to a sober adult and the mother was transported to the Park County Jail.

Wednesday, 03/21/2018-Arrest for Sex Assault, Alma Area

At 04:21 on Wednesday, March 21 Deputies responded to a residence outside of Alma at a report of a possible sex assault that was called into Park County Communications by the alleged victim. The female party in the residence reported that she had been assaulted by a known male party who was subsequently located in a vehicle outside of the home. The intoxicated male party was arrested on an outstanding Boulder County warrant, transported to the Park County Jail and the female party was taken to Summit Medical to be medically cleared. Detectives conducted their investigation and the male was then charged with Sexual Assault (a class 2 felony).

Wednesday, 03/21/2018-Arrest for Road Rage/Felony Menacing, Hoosier Pass

A Park County Deputy responded to the Summit County side of Hoosier Pass on Highway 9 where SCSO Deputies had stopped the two vehicles involved in a reported incident of road rage involving a weapon that had occurred in Park County. The male party who was the suspect in the incident stated to the PCSO Deputy "I messed up" and said he had held his pistol by the barrel to attempt to back off a tailgater. The reporting party's statement differed somewhat and the male party was arrested and charged with Felony Menacing (a class 5 felony) and was transported to the Park County Jail.
