Deputy involved in Minor Accident PCHS

A Deputy at Platte Canyon High School backed his marked patrol vehicle into a parked car at PCHS during the afternoon of Friday, April 06. Another Deputy responded and took the report. Information was exchanged between the parties.

Transient Arrested for False Reporting to Authorities in Fairplay

Very early on Sunday Morning, April 08, 2018 Deputies were notified of suspicious activity in the Family Dollar parking lot in Fairplay. Three people were sleeping in the vehicle and while two were cleared by Park County Communications, the third came back as "Not on File" with the name and date of birth he verbally provided. The male party was detained and transported to the Park County Jail for fingerprinting on the Live Scan to determine his identity. At the jail he advised a Detention Deputy of his true name, but gave a date of birth that was one year off. This was corrected by way of fingerprints. The party was found to have a non-extraditable warrant from Florida but now has new Park County charges.

Warrant Arrest near Hartsel When a Deputy responded to an address near Hartsel on a report of an attempted auto theft in progress on Sunday, April 8, 2018 at approximately 06:23 AM one of the parties contacted had a valid extraditable warrant out of Las Animas County. She was arrested and transported to the Park County Jail.

Arrest for Driving under Revocation and Other Charges On Monday morning, April 09, 2018 at around 09:35 a Deputy observed a vehicle weaving on CR 72 near Bailey. The vehicle crossed the center line and then left the roadway on the right side. A traffic stop was initiated and the driver was shown to have a valid Park County warrant for *Failure to Comply*. In addition, her driver's license was revoked for a refusal to submit to chemical testing during an earlier arrest; the registration on the vehicle had expired in October of 2017 and the year tab on the number plate was issued to a trailer, not a Subaru. She was transported to the Park County Jail and charged with *Fictitious Plates; Owner Operated Uninsured Motor Vehicle; Driving under Restraint (revoked – alcohol) and Driving under the Influence*. Even though she denied consuming any alcohol she showed .222 on the Portable Breath Test (PBT) at intake at 10:53 AM.
