

**PARK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE
WEEKLY ACTIVITY REPORT
APRIL 27, 2018 THROUGH MAY 03, 2018**

Jail Activity in April, 2018

During April, Detention Deputies recovered two "shanks" (weapons) from a housing unit. These were found during a routine "shakedown". Due to the location where they were concealed Deputies were unable to connect these to any specific inmate. The following week Detention Deputies conducted another surprise shakedown and found that an inmate attempted to flush "hooch" (home-made alcohol) down the toilet in his cell when the shakedown began. A presumptive test showed .3% alcohol. The inmate admitted to the offense. Due to the offender having a federal sentence to be followed by a Colorado state sentence yet to be served, only administrative charges were pursued against the inmate and his cellmate.

Domestic Violence, Bailey

On Saturday, April 28, 2018 a male party called into Park County Communications to report that his girlfriend had hit him during an argument. After interviewing the two parties and a witness the female party was arrested and transported to the Park County Jail. She was charged with *Harassment; Child Abuse and Domestic Violence Enhancer*. The male party was issued a summons for *Harassment; Child Abuse and Domestic Violence Enhancer*.

Stolen Vehicle Recovered from Accident Scene, Bailey

Early Sunday morning April 29, 2018, a male party called to Park County Communications report that his vehicle had been stolen sometime the previous night. Coincidentally, 23 minutes earlier the Colorado State Patrol responded to an accident called in by a resident from the Bailey who had opened his door and discovered the car in his yard. The reported number plates matched the reportedly stolen vehicle. The owner of the car was interviewed and claimed he had last seen his car at approximately 8:00 PM the night before. He was also asked about the apparent recent damage to the rear of the vehicle and claimed it was like that when he bought it three or four years previously. In a separate interview the party's mother gave a different story. The deputy had noticed a damaged tree on his way to the scene and noted that it appeared to match the damage on the vehicle which did not display any rust on the bare metal. The driver stated that he did not drive the vehicle as his license is currently revoked/suspended. The stolen vehicle was recovered and the Colorado State Patrol took the accident report.

Warrant Arrest, Sheriff's Office, Fairplay A previously arrested party came into the Sheriff's Office to recover his vehicle which had been impounded for a search warrant. He was suspected of having a warrant, though when contacted he claimed not to have any identification and gave a false name. When Deputies again contacted the male party he attempted to walk away, but was detained and the warrant confirmed. He came back to jail.

DUI-D Arrest, Fairplay

At approximately 6:15 PM a Deputy made a traffic stop north of Fairplay for following too closely and immediately noticed the strong odor of Marijuana emanating from the driver's compartment. The driver claimed that since he was under a court order not to consume or possess alcohol or controlled substance

he hadn't smoked marijuana in "quite a while". Voluntary Standard Field Sobriety Tests gave a different story and the driver was arrested for *Driving under the Influence of Drugs* and was transported to the Park County Jail after refusing the optional blood draw. The vehicle was turned over to the female passenger, who also retrieved two containers of marijuana and a glass pipe for the Deputy.

DUI Arrest, Fairplay

While driving on Hwy 285 near Fairplay on Monday, April 30, 2018, a Deputy observed a vehicle pull on to the highway and forcing another vehicle to use their brakes to avoid a collision. As the Deputy followed the car he saw it cross the center line and then enter a dead-end street and attempt a U-turn. When contacted the driver's breath gave off the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage. An attempt was made to perform SFSTs, but the maneuvers were stopped for the driver's safety due to performance issues. The driver was arrested for *Driving under the Influence of Alcohol* and *Prohibited use of a Weapon* (possessing firearms when intoxicated). He chose a blood draw and was transported to the Park County Jail.

DUI Arrest, Bailey

At around 11:00PM on Monday, April 30, 2018 a Deputy responded to the report of an accident near CR 43 and Conestoga. When on scene the Deputy became aware of the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on the driver's breath and bloodshot, watery eyes. The driver did state he had consumed one beer. The driver volunteered to perform SFSTs, but these were stopped for the driver's safety due to performance issues. He was taken in to custody, refused both blood and breath tests, was transported to the Park County Jail and charged with *Driving Under the Influence*.

Burglary Report, Hartsel

A Deputy responded to an under-construction residence near Hartsel where a utility shed had been broken into. This is one more reported burglary in the Hartsel area currently under investigation.

Report of Stolen Mail, Bailey

Deputy took a report of mail possibly being stolen in the Bailey area. The reporting party uses the USPS Informed Delivery email service, yet his mail box was empty twice when he should have received mail.

Stolen Trees, Bailey

Report taken of approximately thirty trees being cut and removed from the party's property when he was out of state.

Reported Theft of Firearms and Jewelry, Bailey

A party reported numerous firearms and pieces of jewelry taken from his residence in 2017 and 2018

Rock Thrown through Window, Bailey

A report was taken and evidence gathered of a rock that was thrown through a window. A known party was named as a possible suspect. The investigation continues.
