



Park County Public Health

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Vendors wishing to rent booth space in Park County at any special event must contact the event coordinator and obtain a copy of the "Mobile Unit or Temporary Food Establishment Application with Commissary Agreement" at <http://www.parkco.us/203/Food-Establishments>. A copy of your state sales tax number, a Colorado retail food license, a schematic of your mobile/ temporary unit including perimeter set up, and a copy of your menu are required.

Some events are sold out months before the event so it is important to plan ahead. Check to see what service hook-ups are available. Don't assume that there will be potable water, dump stations, trash removal or electricity.

Non-profit entities are exempt from retail food licensing. However, non-profit entities must complete contact the event coordinator and submit the "Mobile Unit or Temporary Food Establishment Application".

Anyone wishing to prepare potentially hazardous foods at any special events in Park County must have a Colorado Retail Food Establishment License such as a mobile or temporary license. We do not recognize licenses from other states. Anyone selling prepackaged, non-potentially hazardous foods (soda, prepackaged candy, chips etc.) are not required to have a license.
